MINUTES State Geographic Information Council Meeting

The State Geographic Information Council met Friday, September 5, 2014 at the Oklahoma Board of Regents Conference Room in Oklahoma City, OK. Council Chair Mike Sharp called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m. The agenda for the meeting was sent out to the GI Community through the OK GIS List serve as well as the OK GI Council Contact Database. - 6. Presentation and discussion of the draft OK Address Standard, version 1.0. Pursuant to Oklahoma Statute Title 82, Section 1501-205.1, paragraph G(1) one of the duties of the Council is the adoption of standards and procedures that may be applied to geographic information. The Council will consider and take possible action concerning the adoption of the OK Address Standard, version 1.0 as presented.
 - Charles Brady III presented the final draft Address Standards to the Council. Discussion was held among the Council members. Kim Carter made a motion to approve the Address Standards. Dr. Steve Stadler seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- 7. Pursuant to Oklahoma Statute Title 82, Section 1501-205.1, paragraph C, that upon recommendation by the Council, the Governor shall appoint to the Council a representative of the Oklahoma Association of Regional Councils, a representative of county assessors and a representative of city government. The following item is presented for the Council's consideration.
 - a. Discussion and possible vote concerning a letter from the Oklahoma Municipal League recommending Charles Brady III, GIS Coordinator-City of Ardmore, to serve as the city government representative on the State Geographic Information Council for a term of four (4) years.
 - Kim Carter made a motion to accept the recommendation of Charles Brady III to serve as the city government representative. Jeff Spelman seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
- 8. Discussion and possible vote concerning the proposed FY'16 budget for the Office of Geographic Information. This budget, pursuant to Title 82:1501-205.3.C, will be included in the FY'16 budget request of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission.
 - Mike Sharp presented the proposed FY'16 budget for the Office of Geographic Information. Discussion was held among the members concerning the budget. Charles Brady III made a motion to approve the proposed budget. Craig Moody seconded the motion. Motion passes unanimously.
